

## Service Bulletin SB-507 Annual FLARM Update

After 12 months of operation, latest on **31 January** of each year, the FLARM license terms require a firmware update of all FLARM devices.

### "Firmware Update Scheme

Read the following information carefully to ensure that your device is always kept serviceable. FLARM uses a rolling release cycle, requiring an annual update. Each update can be applied anytime during a rolling one year period. This makes it easier to align FLARM firmware updates with the yearly aircraft maintenance. It is also in line with the maintenance care that a safety system requires. As the update cycle is individual, no generic information is sent out on individual firmware expiration dates."

You can update the Planetrack ADS-B/FLARM Type B-FLARM ground station yourself.

- Please have an **empty USB stick ready**.
- Goto <https://flarm.com/support/firmware-updates/download-firmware/> and scroll down to
  - Downloads
  - PowerFLARM Core and PowerFLARM Portable
- Select the link "Download Firmware version x.xx" and click (per January 2020 the current version is 6.82)
- **Download** the file and copy it from your computer onto an empty USB stick.
- **Switch OFF** (0) the Ground Station.



- **Insert the USB stick to the MTC port.**



- **Switch ON (1) the Ground Station. DO NOT REMOVE THE USB-STICK.**



- **After 5 minutes** check the status of the Ground Station. In your web browser enter <http://<ip-address>:9090/status>

After a few minutes the \$PFLAU, \$PGRMZ, \$PFLAL messages should be present.

There should be no message "Firmware expired".

- You can remove the USB stick after normal operations was verified. **DO NOT REMOVE THE USB-STICK EARLIER THAN AT THIS TIME.**
